Missing Something? It only takes a second to lose your data - or worse, destroy a computer component. One small power interruption (a quick off/on of electricity) or power surge (when voltage momentarily increases well beyond what the computer requires) can have a serious affect on your computer equipment, data and consequently the operation of your business!

Reduce your risk! Install a UPS (uninterruptible power supply), also known as a battery back-up on every piece of electronic or computer equipment you can afford to. A UPS provides emergency power to connected equipment by supplying power from a separate source when utility power is not available. The 5-15 minutes a UPS provides will allow you to safely shut down your equipment and reduce or eliminate serious business interruptions. For around \$100 per device, you'll be able to protect your data, equipment and sleep at night!
