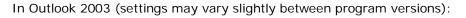


Technology Tip July 2008

The Two Minute Delay That Could Save Your Life: **Part Two**

In the April newsletter, we shared information on how to activate the Outlook feature that will (thankfully) delay the sending of email messages for a specified amount of time, i.e., 2 minutes. This month, we thought you might want to know how to temporarily override this feature so you can send urgent messages immediately.



- BEFORE you click "New Message", from the top menu, select
- Tools
- ✓ Rules & Alerts
- ✓ Find the "Delay Sending" rule. It will appear as something like, "1 Minute Delay" (or whatever you called it when you created it)
- ✓ Click the checked box to the left to "uncheck" it
- ✓ You've now turned the rule off
- ✓ Click Apply ✓ Click OK
- ✓ Once you've composed and sent your email, follow the same instructions to turn the Delay Sending feature on again.

Simplicity rules!
